¹ Unless granted an exemption by the Regional Council of Emmaus Europe upon substantiated application, member organisations may only vote if they are up to date with payment of their subscriptions to Emmaus Europe since the last General Assembly, i.e., from 2023 up to, and including, 2025.

² More specifically to its voting representative, with a maximum of two proxies per group.

³ The President of Emmaus Europe will distribute blank proxies among the groups present.

Mandate: A mandate is a document by which the legal representative of a member organisation authorises a member of their choice to represent that organisation and vote on its behalf.

Proxy: A proxy is a document by which a member organisation authorises another member organisation to represent it and vote on its behalf at the Regional Assembly when it cannot participate itself. It may be issued in the name of a specific organisation or left blank.
